

- 401.76 LOT OF RECORD - A lot which is a part of a subdivision, the map of which has been recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, or a lot described by metes and bounds, the deed to which has been recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds at the time this Ordinance is passed.
- 401.77 LOT, CORNER - A lot abutting upon two (2) or more streets at their intersection or upon two parts of the same street, such streets or parts of the same street forming an interior angle of less than one hundred thirty-five (135) degrees. The point of intersection of the street lines is the "corner".
- 401.78 LOT, DOUBLE FRONTAGE - A lot having frontage on two (2) non-intersecting streets as distinguished from a corner lot.
- 401.79 LOT, FRONTAGE - See LOT LINE, FRONT.
- 401.80 LOT INTERIOR - A lot other than a corner or reversed corner lot.
- 401.81 LOT LINE, FRONT - The Boundary of a lot abutting a street. On a corner lot, the shortest street lot line shall be the front lot line.
- 401.82 LOT LINE, REAR - The lot line opposite and most distant from the front lot line.
- 401.83 LOT LINE, SIDE - Any lot line other than a front or rear lot line. A side lot line separating a lot from a street is called a side street lot line. A side lot line separating a lot from another lot or lots is called an interior side lot line.
- 401.84 LOT WIDTH - The horizontal distance between the side lot lines measured at right angles to the lot depth at the established front building line.
- 401.85 METES AND BOUNDS - A method of property description by means of their direction and distance from an easily identifiable point.
- 401.86 MOBILE HOME - See DWELLING, MOBILE HOME.
- 401.87 MOBILE HOME PARK - Any park, mobile park, mobile court, mobile camp, court, campsite, lot, parcel or tract of land designed, maintained, or intended for the purpose of supplying a long term location or accommodations for any mobile home and upon which any mobile home, coach, or mobile home coaches are parked, and shall include all buildings used or equipment thereof, intended for use as a part of the whether or not a change is made for the use of the mobile home park and its facilities. Mobile home parks shall not include vehicle or mobile home sales lots on which unoccupied mobile homes are parked for the purpose of inspection, display, and sale.
- 401.88 MOBILE HOME LOT - A parcel of land rented or sold for the exclusive use of the occupants of a single mobile home.
