

materials shall not be shown or exhibited so as to be visible to the public from pedestrian sidewalks, walkways or from other public or semi-public areas.

4. Minors. No minor, as defined in Section 1317.1(I), shall be permitted in any establishment in which adult uses are permitted.

5. Alcohol. No alcohol shall be permitted in any establishment in which adult uses are permitted, unless such is specifically allowed pursuant to the Code of Iowa. This prohibition applies equally to the proprietor and the patrons of the establishment involved.

6. Public Exposure. Except as hereinafter provided, no person shall expose those parts of his or her body, hereinafter listed, to another in any public place, in any privately owned place open to the public, or in any place where such exposure is seen by another person or persons located in any public place:

- a) A woman's nipple, the areola thereof, or full breast, except as necessary in the breast-feeding of a baby.
- b) The pubic hair, pubes, perineum or anus of a male or female, the penis or scrotum of a male or the vagina of a female, excepting such body parts of prepubescent infants of either sex.
- c) This subsection does not apply to limited or minimal exposures incident to the use of public rest rooms or locker rooms or such other places where such exposures occur incident to the prescribed use of those facilities. This subsection also does not apply to exposures occurring in live stage plays, live theatrical performances or live dance performances conducted in a theater, concert hall or similar establishment which is primarily devoted to theatrical performances.

#### 1317.4 Violation.

A violation of this Subdivision shall result in those penalties applicable to Section 1600 of the Zoning Ordinances.
