  - a. Public hearing and possible action on a variance request submitted by property owner Jeff Shepley, in coordination with The Overland Group, LLC, to allow for 35 off-street parking spaces for a proposed Dollar General retail store, in lieu of the 75 spaces required under Subdivision 1312.12340 of the City of Baxter Zoning Ordinance.
