EMS Update: Mayor Bishop gave update regarding transition from West Malaka Fire District to City as of July 1, 2024. The city has renewed its Medicare provider renewal application. The city needs to apply to have the EMS Provider number tied to the City's Federal Id number. EMS Interim Director gave 2nd quarterly report.

Milligan moved to approve entering into an agreement with PCC to establish provider enrollment agreement with Medicare, Medicaid, and major insurance carries on behalf of the City of Baxter. Kinzel seconded. 5-ayes, motion carried.

Public Safety/Office Administrator: Milligan reported that after June 24, 2024, meeting the candidate withdrew application. Mayor Bishop appointed Kunkel be council liaison for this position. Discussion was held.

BEDC Report: John Northrup, Bedc President, gave BEDC report. Topics were current board members, TIF Rebate agreement, Trailer Park Loan, Boost grant received from Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA), and purchase of lots.

Maintenance: Halter submitted written report and informed council manhole replacement crews are in Baxter, surveyor is on site for water treatment plant property, and gave update on the Lead and Copper line survey required by DNR.

City Clerk Report: Van Houten gave report regarding the process to establish campground policies for Giese Park. With computer issues last 5 days – Reservation system is on hold.

Hometown Pride gave report. Topics included Giese Park campground policies and regulations.

Library Director Report – Written report was submitted. Library Director Marie VanBeck's retirement reception will be held at Giese Park on August 4, 2024, at 3 p.m.

Driveway property located on West Avenue: Driveway curb cut is wider than allowed. Developer's options were discussed. Smith moved to allow the developer 30 days from July 8, 2024, to decide how developer would like to proceed. Churchill seconded. Ayes: Churchill, Kinzel, Milligan, and Smith. Abstain: Kunkel. Motion carried. The developer verbally mentioned filing for variance with board of adjustments.

Milligan moved to purchase pumps for the wastewater system. Kinzel seconded. 5-ayes, motion carried.

Public Comments: Topics discussed were the Boost Grant, working together, Iowa Department of Economic Authority (IDEA) future grant opportunities, IDEA's insistence on contractors must follow rules, BEDC agenda and minutes.
